It is hereby notified for the information of all the students that 'The Department of Higher Education, Government of Jammu and Kashmir in association with University of Jammu, is organising a "College on Wheels" program. Under this program, the selected female students of various Degree colleges of Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir will undertake a sponsored journey that will commence from Jammu and the students shall visit Delhi, Ahmedabad, Mumbai, Goa, Bengaluru, Wardha and back to Jammu. *The tentative dates of the Journey are from 15th Nov to 30th Nov, 2023.*

The selection of the students shall be made on the basis of projects connected to various aspects of the journey ranging from design of coaches, toilets and engines; to ideas and problems connected with the land; and places through which the journey passes. *The projects may also be based on culture, economy, history and entrepreneurship of the places of halt.*

The journey will take the students to various places of significance like Delhi University, Sabarmati Ashram, Gujarat Vidyapeeth, Surat, the INS Vikrant at the naval dockyard of Mumbai, the entrepreneurial activities of Goa, ISRO & IISc Bengaluru and the Gandhi Ashram of Wardha. At the conclusion of the journey, the students shall be required to submit a detailed project report.

In this regard, **NOMINATIONS** are hereby invited along with the **PROJECT PROPOSAL** on various topics mentioned above (*Proposal format and tentative themes are enclosed in the pdf, attached herewith for ready reference*). The interested candidates shall provide their names and submit the Project proposal in word file (soft copy) to Dr. Rajni Khajuria, Department of Chemistry, by 7th September, 2023.

The first counselling session on the significance of the program shall be held on 4th September, 2023 in Multipurpose Hall (MPH) at 11:00 AM.

सभी छात्रों की जानकारी के लिए यह सूचित किया जाता है कि 'जम्मू और कश्मीर सरकार का उच्च शिक्षा विभाग, जम्मू विश्वविद्यालय के सहयोग से एक "कॉलेज ऑन व्हील्स" कार्यक्रम का आयोजन कर रहा है। इस कार्यक्रम के तहत, केंद्र शासित प्रदेश जम्मू और कश्मीर के विभिन्न डिग्री कॉलेजों की चयनित छात्राएं एक प्रायोजित यात्रा करेंगी जो जम्मू से शुरू होगी और छात्राएं दिल्ली, अहमदाबाद, मुंबई, गोवा, बेंगलुरु, वर्धा का दौरा करेंगी और वापस जम्मू आएंगी। यात्रा की अस्थायी तारीखें 15 नवंबर से 30 नवंबर, 2023 तक हैं।

छात्रों का चयन कोच, शौचालय और इंजन के डिजाइन से लेकर यात्रा के विभिन्न पहलुओं से जुड़ी परियोजनाओं के आधार पर किया जाएगा; भूमि से जुड़े विचारों और समस्याओं के लिए; और वे स्थान जहां से यात्रा गुजरती है। परियोजनाएं पड़ाव स्थलों की संस्कृति, अर्थव्यवस्था, इतिहास और उद्यमशीलता पर भी आधारित हो सकती हैं।

यह यात्रा छात्रों को दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय, साबरमती आश्रम, गुजरात विद्यापीठ, सूरत, मुंबई के नौसैनिक गोदी में आईएनएस विक्रान्त, गोवा की उद्यमशीलता गतिविधियों, इसरो और आईआईएससी बेंगलुरु और वर्धा के गांधी आश्रम जैसे विभिन्न महत्वपूर्ण स्थानों पर ले जाएगी। यात्रा के समापन पर, छात्रों को एक विस्तृत परियोजना रिपोर्ट जमा करनी होगी।

इस संबंध में, उपरोक्त उल्लिखित विभिन्न विषयों पर परियोजना प्रस्ताव के साथ नामांकन आमंत्रित किए जाते हैं (प्रस्ताव प्रारूप और अस्थायी विषय पीडीएफ में संलग्न हैं, त्वरित संदर्भ के लिए इसके साथ संलग्न हैं)।
