## Green Campus initiatives taken in the college

- The Restricted entry of automobiles: The vehicles of the staff and students are parked in designated parking space located on the front side of college. No vehicle is allowed to enter the areas the undesignated spaces. The campus is fully fenced and gate keeper allows the entry of automobiles after proper verification.
- Sensitization about environment friendly practices: The college sensitizes the students about various environmentally friendly practices and aspects for maintaining a clean \& green environment. Various days are celebrated like world Environment Day, Nature conservation Day, Ozone Day, World Biodiversity Day etc. through symposiums, seminars, essay competitions, plantation drives, painting competitions every year. The students are sensitized about necessary measures for solid/Liquid waste management and water/Energy conservation, environmental pollution, its effects. Use of single use plastics for serving the food items is not permitted in the campus and canteen. The students are encouraged for the use of bicycles and battery powered vehicles through these events. Also, Environmental Studies is being taught to the students of semester first and second to enhance their knowledge about various environmental aspects.
- Landscaping with trees and pedestrian friendly walk ways: Govt. Degree College for Women has an eco-friendly lush green well maintained pollution-free campus sprawling over 60 kanals of land. ## Solid Waste Management

The solid waste generated in the gardens, canteen and in other places is collected separately in two different bins and adequately disposed by composting or other means.

## Liquid Waste Management

The liquid waste is collected in sewage tanks.

## Water Conservation and Management

An energy efficient water management system is used in the college to supply the water without any wastage from the underground tank to rooftop storage tanks kept at the building. The water purifiers have been installed and are regularly cleaned and maintained.

The pamphlets regarding judicious use of water and to keep the taps fully off to avoid wastage of water are pasted near the water points.

The chowkidar of the college has been entrusted with the responsibility for filling up of water tanks at the roof tops so that regular supply of water may be ensured.

The students and faculty members are aware to save electric energy by switching off the lights/fans/appliances when not in use.

## Energy Conservation

For conservation of energy, traditional bulbs have been replaced by LED lights in the entire college campus.

## Noise Pollution Management

(i) Silence zones in the college: Various pamphlets have been placed in the library and outside classrooms for awareness to maintain silence in the college.
(ii) Noise control in the college: The Physical Director of the college ensure a noise free campus in the college and chowkidar looks after the smooth entry and exit of students without any noise. The playing of music in the campus is not allowed without proper permission by the college.

## Air Pollution Management

The air quality of college campus is ensured by large number of trees in the campus. The College conducts awareness programmes for staff, students and society for protecting and maintaining the air quality and its impacts on health. The Restricted entry of automobiles: The vehicles of the staff and students are parked in designated parking space located on the front side of college. No vehicle is allowed to enter the areas the undesignated spaces. The campus is fully fenced and gate keeper allows the entry of automobiles after proper verification.
Ban on Single-use Plastics on the Campus: The use of single use plastics in college campus is strictly banned as per guidelines of UGC and Govt. of India. The students are sensitized about harmful effects of use of plastics on human health and environment. The display boards regarding no plastic use have been displayed at various points in the college campus.
