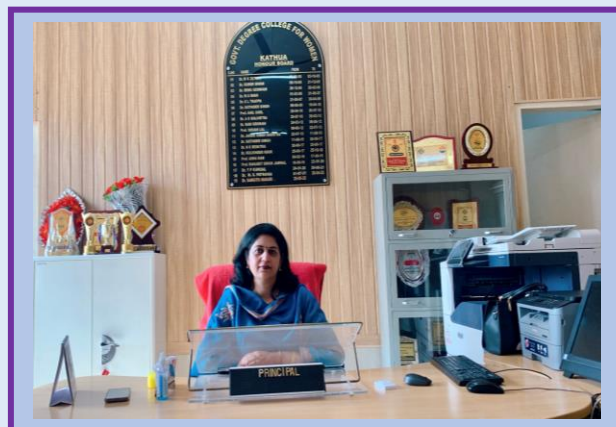

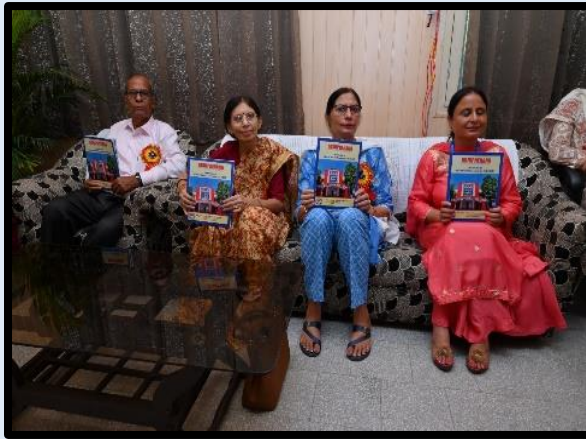

17th-18th, of Nov, 2022

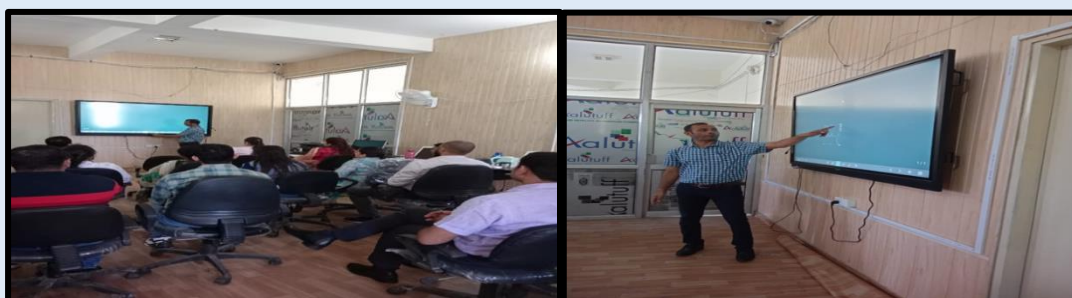

It is also celebrated by singing traditional songs and preparing Dogra dishes like Kiur, Roott etc. Rade is a month-long festival. At the end of the month well developed plants are dug up with earthen pots i.e. Rade and immerse them in river water. The college celebrated Rade Utsav for a month with continuous activities including online lectures and other programs for the students. The

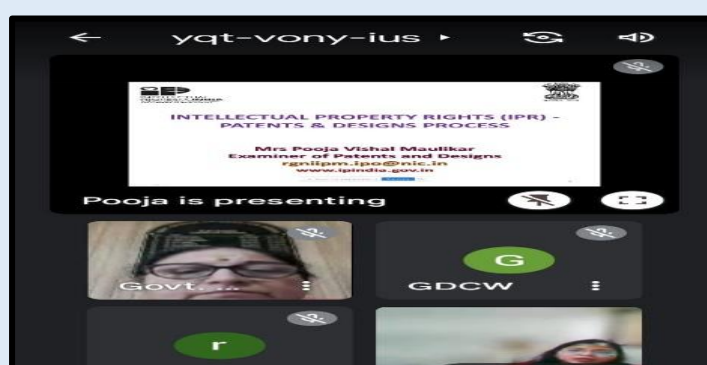


One-Day Online Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

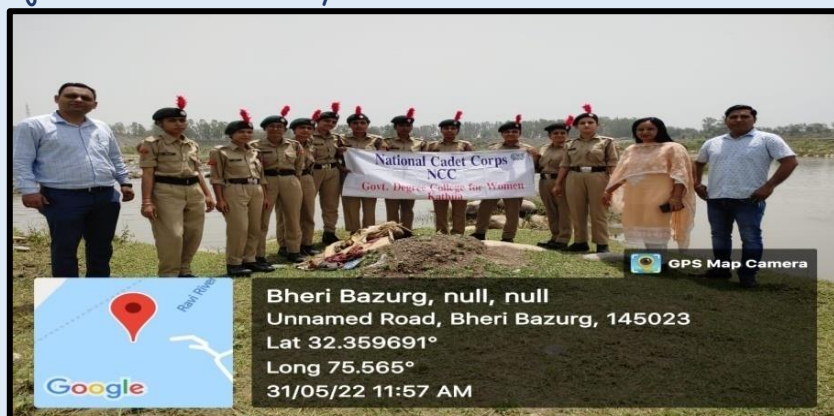


Activities of National Cadet Corps (NCC) Unit

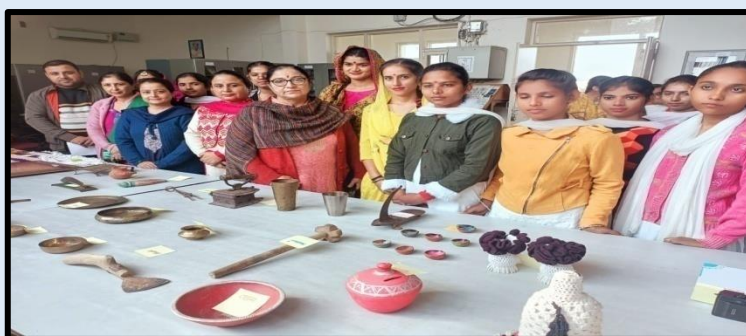


Organisation of an exhibition on the Cultural Heritage of Kathua

Organisation of an Online Lecture on Stress and Meditation

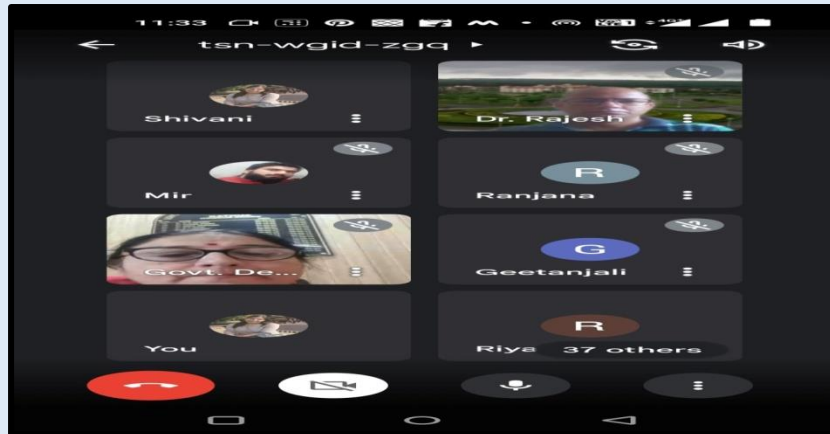
12th of August, 2022.

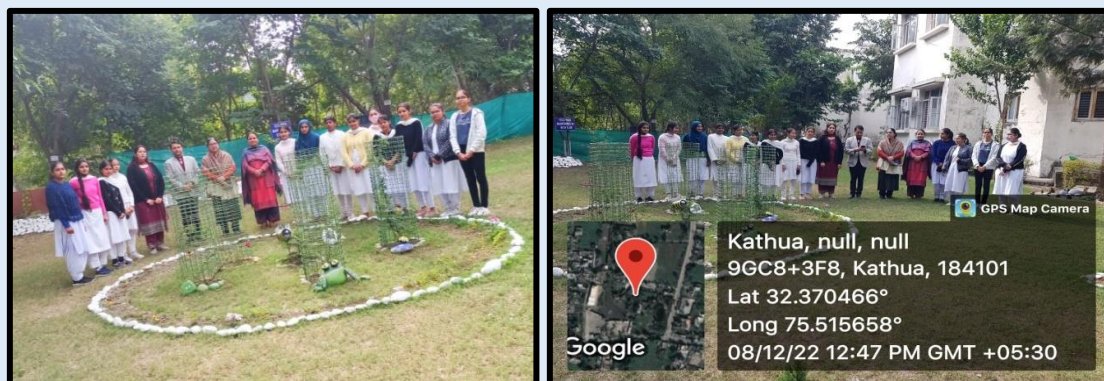
