Govt. Degree College for Women, Kathua was established in 2005, by an order of Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir. The college is recognized by the U.G.C. under section 2 (f), 12 (B) and is eligible to receive central assistance from the U.G.C. under various schemes. College was NAAC accredited (first cycle) on 28-08-2022 with B<sup>+</sup> Grade.

**Infrastructure: -**

The campus of the college is spread over an environment friendly area of about 60 Kanals, which consists of administrative section, classrooms, laboratories and Library Block. The lush green lawns in front of the building are creating learner friendly ambience. The college has sufficient infrastructure facilities like Digital Classrooms, Multipurpose Hall, Open-Air theatre and Browsing Centre.

Institute is well equipped with one smart class room and interactive boards have been installed in the classrooms and the Labs which serve as platforms for encouraging creativity and increasing awareness among the students.

To facilitate conduct of college events such as conferences, workshops, seminars, and cultural events, the college has one big MPH. It is well-furnished and equipped with modern projection and PA system.

In addition, the administrative block has been upgraded this year. A girl's common room and four additional classrooms have also been constructed. Furthermore, two fabricated classrooms have been added as part of the recent developments. The college has started Skill Courses in collaboration with Central University, Jammu & NIELIT to impart skill-based education to the students. The college has adequate sports infrastructure for Badminton Kho- Kho, Volley Ball, Table Tennis and Cricket.
