Govt. Degree College for Women, Kathua was established in 2005, by an order of Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir. The college is recognized by the U.G.C. under section 2 (f), 12 (B). The campus of the college is spread over an environment friendly area of about 60 Kanals, which consists of administrative section, classrooms, laboratories and Library. The lush green lawns in front of the building is creating learner friendly ambience. The college has sufficient infrastructure facilities like Digital Classrooms, Multipurpose Hall, Open Air theatre and Browsing Centre. The Multipurpose Hall of the college is being used for organizing various curricular activities. At present, the college is offering courses in Arts Stream and Science Stream. The college has excelled in bagging top position in the University results.MsShammi Devi secured fifth University position in BA Sem VI for the session 2020-21. The college has started Skill Courses in collaboration with Central University, Jammu & NIELIT to impart skill-based education to the students. The college has adequate sports infrastructure for Badminton Kho, Volley Ball, Table Tennis and Cricket. Govt. Degree College for women, Kathua conducted an awareness campaign on National Education Policy (NEP) on 16th September 2021. Dr M. S. Pathania, Worthy Principal of the college, presented and discussed various features and implementation process of the National Education Policy (NEP). He emphasized upon how the NEP has paved way for transformational reforms in the school and higher education system in the country. New policy promotes Multilingualism in both schools and HEs. The policy envisages broad based, multi-disciplinary, holistic Under Graduate education with flexible curricula, create combinations of subjects, integration of vocational education and multiple entry and exit points with appropriate certification. UG education can be of 3 or 4 years with multiple exit points and appropriate certification within this period. For example, certificate after 1-year, Advanced Diploma after 2 years, Bachelor's Degree after 3 years and Bachelor's with Research after 4 years. All the staff members were presented and gave their valuable inputs on the said matter.

A Two-Days Workshop on ICT at GDC for Women Kathua




Organisation of Online Workshop on "Rural Entrepreneurship Development Programme


